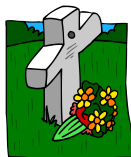


A CONVOCATION ON MARRIAGE AND FAMILY LIFE

DIOCESAN YOUTH PROTECTION POLICY

Every allegation of child abuse must be reported to the Child Protection Services, an agency of the Indiana State government. Any person who has "reason to believe" must report.

In the event of an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor (person under 18) by diocesan personnel, report the allegation to authorities and inform the Victims Assistance Coordinator for the diocese – toll free (866) 200-3004 or local (812) 490-9565.
