THE GABRIEL PROJECT

The Angel Gabriel told Mary not to be afraid, "For nothing is impossible with God". This is the foundation for the Gabriel Project, which is coordinated by Catholic Charities and the Vanderburgh County Right to Life. The Gabriel Project is a special ministry that reaches out to women **IN THE COMMUNITY** who are dealing with unplanned pregnancies. The hope is to help these women choose life and avoid abortion. Gabriel Angels offer emotional and spiritual support, friendship, referrals for resources, and love in hopes that they can guide their beneficiaries to a better place spiritually, emotionally, and physically.

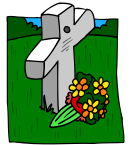
