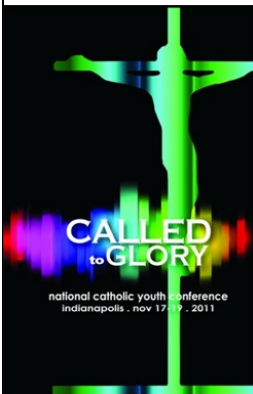

NCYC-NATIONAL CATHOLIC YOUTH CONFERENCE



All High School students of Good Shepherd are invited to join the Diocese of Evansville as we head to Indianapolis, IN for the **2011 National Catholic Youth Conference** on November 17, 18, and 19, 2011. NCYC is the premiere national gathering of 25,000 Catholic high school age youth in the United States. It is a unique opportunity for young people to gather together to strengthen their Catholic identity. They meet other young people striving to live

out positive values, learn ways to cope with influences that conflict with what they know to be right, and find that they are strong enough to make a difference in the world today. Our youth will hear presentations by leading national speakers on wide array of topics including social justice, prayer, appropriate use of technology, and servant leadership. Good Shepherd Youth Ministry has been raising funds for this event. Our cheese ball and pretzel fundraiser has produced revenue to help defray the cost of this trip. The Diocese is charging \$365 per person. The cost for our youth is only \$200 per person. This cost will be further reduced according to the money we raise on this year's fundraiser sales. CURSILLO

Have you ever wondered "What is Cursillo"?

Cursillo means "Short Course".

Cursillo is a Catholic movement for men and women to get closer to God. It is a three night, three day weekend that starts on Thursday night around 6 pm and ends on Sunday night around 8 pm. The Cursillo is for those who are far from the knowledge that God loves them, for those who are busy, work hard, come home tired, who can't find answers. This is a way that Christ can become the center of their lives.

Cursillo is meant to be a way to ask individuals to make a decision for Christ in solitude. Mixed Cursillos may distract, therefore, the men and women weekends are separate. It is to be an encounter with self that requires separation from ordinary life, especially for those who do not have the luxury in their daily lives to spend needed time alone with God.

Cursillo describes what is fundamental for being Christian, which is "God loves you." We need to hear that in order to be loved, so that in being loved we can in turn love others. If we say this only to the leaders of an environment it is for efficiency sake, as leaders can make the process go quicker. Ultimately, all could make a Cursillo. All need to hear that God loves them.

God's grace finds expression in Cursillo; optimism, joy, courage, and constancy. It is Christ-centered logic, faith in the Resurrection, recognizing that life is beautiful, important, and worth living. You do need a sponsor to sign up for a week-end (this is anyone that has made a Cursillo week-end). They are held at the Sarto Retreat House, by the Catholic Center. The cost is \$125.00. This is for a private room w/bath and plenty of FOOD and getting closer to God, Priceless!
