

K-3 PE Guidelines

Expectations:

- Positive Attitude (good sportsmanship)
- Full Participation
- Listen to and follow instructions
- Develop physical and social skills
- Be a “team” player
- Respect classmates/teacher
- Have FUN

Supplies:

Each student is expected to wear **tennis shoes with laces** (preferred) and participate unless there is a doctor/nurse’s note excusing them from physical activity. **Girls must pull their hair back in a pony tail; however, a headband may be worn if the length does not allow for a pony tail. Earrings and/or taping the ears are not permitted.** **Please see handbook.*

The above guidelines are to help the students have a safe and fun physical education experience.

The **grading scale** for physical education for K–2 is a letter system. We use the letters **P, I, N** which stand for the following:

P – Proficient

I – Is understanding

N – Needs Improvement

Each grade (K–2) has three categories on which the student will be evaluated.

The grade will be determined by the expectations above.
